Co-owner Responsibilities

1. The Co-owner must take full responsibility for said Dog's care. All vaccination records must be available for inspection. The Dog must also have all regular boosters and immunizations recommended by Canario Club .

2. The Co-owner must give the Dog proper nutritional concern as per Canario Club's recommendations.

3. In the event of accident or injury, the Co-owner must immediately inform the Breeder of Dog's condition.

Any necessary veterinary or hospital charges are the responsibility of the Co-owner.

4. The Co-owner is responsible for registering for both Puppy and Adult with CCC in a timely manner. Please refer to the Puppy Registration Letter for additional information.

5. The Co-owner must agree to give the Dog proper socialization for mental health and stability.

Puppy Sale and Placement

1. The Co-owner agrees to give the Breeder _____ f of the puppies from the first litter (as per contract guidelines). The party whelping the litter would keep the "odd" puppy (eq. Bitch produces seven pups:

Breeder keeps three; Co-owner keeps four). The stud fee is the responsibility of the Co-Owner.

3. The puppies should be delivered to the Breeder in good health at seven or eight weeks of age for inspection. The Breeder reserves the right to refuse any puppies that are not up to standard within 48 hours of delivery. Any puppies that show symptoms of any contagious disease or die within ten days will not be responsibility of *breeder*.

4. The Co-owner agree to give full details to Breeder as to weight, temperament, etc., and agrees that pupsshould be priced as per CCC guidelines.

Legalities

In the event the Dog is lost, killed, or injured seriously, so as to render her unable to be bred, in consequence of any Co-owner negligence, or that of his/her agents or employees, the sum of \$1,000.00

is to be paid promptly to the Breeder as liquidated damages. Further, the Breeder shall have the right to repossess said Dog.

1. Should the Co-owner find him/herself unable or unwilling to fully comply with the terms of this contract, with respect to care, breeding, whelping, etc., the Dog must be returned to _____ forthwith. Failure to return the Dog under these circumstances, the Co-owner hereby gives the Breeder the following

options: 1.

The Breeder's agent may take possession of the Dog from the Co-owner's property, providing the Dog is in good health; and the Co-owner signs the CCC paperwork completely to the Breeder, making this contract null and void;

or 2.

The Breeder can subject the Co-owner to liquidated damages in the amount of \$5,000.00, attorney's fees in the amount of \$500.00, and the legal cost of bringing this action to enforce the terms of the contract.

I have read and understood the terms and conditions for this contract and agree to abide by them until such time as the contract is fulfilled.
